Publication ethics

1. General provisions and standards

Publication ethics of the *Voprosy kiberbezopasnosti* journal is in line with rules and regulations established by the international Committee on Publication Ethics – <u>COPE</u>, set out in the Code of Conduct for editors and respective Best Practices, and principles of the Association of Science Editors and Publishers (<u>ASEP</u>) laid down in the declaration "Ethical principles of scientific papers"¹.

Researchers (authors) and experts (reviewers) in the subject field – problems of information security are to adhere to professional ethics, for instance, of <u>ISACA</u> and <u>(ISC)2</u> communities.

OPENNESS and AWARENESS² of the journal activity are basic **regulatory** principles and management thereof.

All and any articles are not paid. The journal does not print commercial ads. Informative matters pertaining to up-to-date scientific activities and achievements are printed free of payment on a first-in first-out basis.

Protection of personal details³ and other secrets as well as intellectual property including protection of copyrights⁴ shall be governed by the RF laws⁵.

2. Specific points

2.1. Guarantees and trust

The authors who file applications for publication of papers in the *Voprosy kiberbezopasnosti* journal are to guarantee correct personal identification details and that the research has been made personally, it is original and is not intended for publishing in any other publication, the research deliverables are authentic, and the paper to be published does not infringe copyrights and other rights, or secrets subject to regulation in the RF. Authors guarantee to the publisher that they will compensate him/her for damage caused by the said infringements.

Reviewers and scientific supervisors requesting the editorial staff to publish a paper shall share responsibility with the authors.

Authors shall transfer to the publisher without charge the exclusive right to the work and property right to the manuscript unless otherwise agreed by the author and publisher. In turn, the publisher shall circulate the published paper under open license with authorship being reserved.

The editorial staff and reviewers appointed by the editorial office guarantee prompt communication and efficiency of the work assumed. The internal review is to be performed within a period of two weeks. A paper accepted for publication is to be printed in one of two next issues (within 6 months).

The editorial staff pursues the policy that prevents content borrowing exceeding 20%. Borrowed matters (illustrations) may be used if there is a reference to a source and authors properly settled borrowing (reprinting) legitimacy issues.

2.3. Conflicts

The editorial staff reserves the right to reject any paper if ethical norms and regulations are violated and, where damage is possible, take relevant inspection and public measures in compliance with the RF laws.
